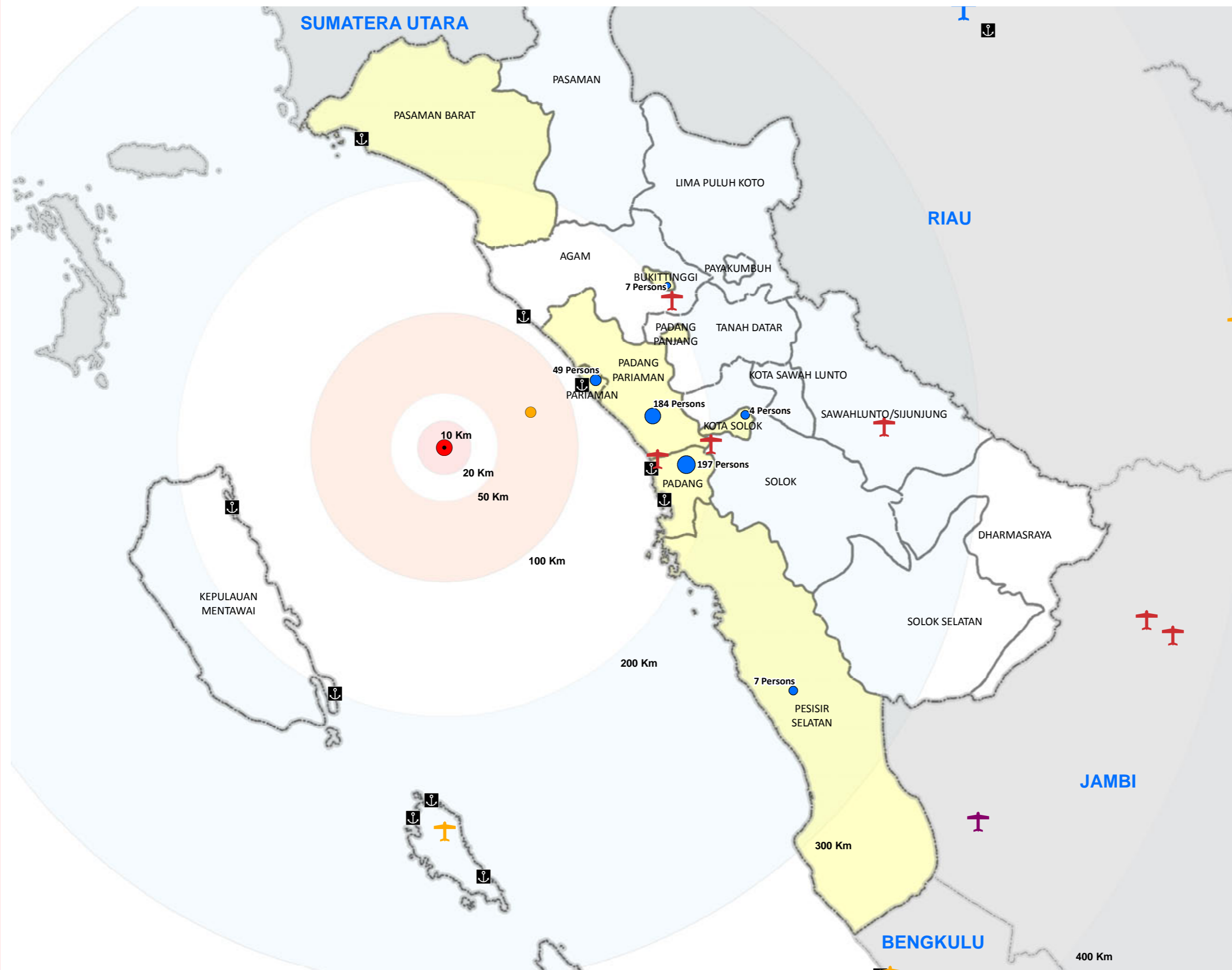


# INDONESIA

 - Increased international humanitarian response, including deployment of SAR teams

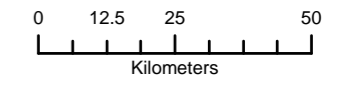
