
Team results and lessons learned

The team was very proud and delighted to hear we finished in the 16th position overall which meant that our team finished in a well renowned US universities.

Our structure performed well in the first ground motion as we predicted, even though it didn't last in the second ground motion. Taking into consideration the soil factor, the accelerations imposed on the building and the

expansion restrictions the addition of a shear wall core and braces on an entire façade made the structure more rigid.







One of our weaknesses was that not all teammates knew how to use structural analysis software's and even knew how to manage a well base theorical of structure, thus one of the aspects our team will focus from now on is to enhance the use and knowledge of those software's in order to have a better understanding in the structural analysis.
