**The Great Sumatra Earthquakes and Indian Ocean Tsunamis of December 26, 2004 and March 28, 2005** caused more than 283,000 fatalities, with the heaviest losses concentrated along the west coast of Aceh, Sumatra, while more than 40,000 died on distant shores around the Indian Ocean. More than 1 million people were displaced. This 900+ page report contains 40+ papers on the topics of seismology, geology, strong ground motion, the tsunami, hydrodynamic observations, structures, lifelines, awareness and preparedness, societal dimensions, response, and recovery, and reconstruction.

**The October 23, 2004, Niigata Ken Chuetsu, Japan, Earthquake** ( $M_w = 6.6$ ) caused 48 deaths, 4,160 injuries, hundreds of major landslides that destroyed entire upland villages and caused extensive damage to roads, rail lines and other lifelines, resulting in major economic disruption and an estimated cost of US \$40 billion. The 180-page report covers seismology and strong ground motions, geotechnical aspects, landslides, building and lifeline aspects, performance of transportation systems, reconnaissance technologies used, terrestrial-LIDAR visualization of surface and structural deformations, and socioeconomic, policy, and planning aspects. 175 pp.

**The Tecomán, Mexico, Earthquake of January 21, 2003:** This magnitude 7.8 earthquake caused 17 fatalities and damage totaling almost US\$130 million. The first joint venture for EERI and the Mexican Society for Earthquake Engineering, this report covers the geostatistical background, seismology and tectonics, geotechnical conditions, lifelines, housing, education and healthcare infrastructure, public and commercial buildings, the response of the Mexican Civil Protection System, and socioeconomic effects. 287 pp.

**The December 26, 2003 Bam, Iran, Earthquake.** This M 6.6 event caused between 31,000 and 43,000 deaths and rendered homeless more than 100,000. In addition to covering the topics of geology, seismology, strong motion measurements, performance of buildings and lifelines, and societal impacts, the report contains a section devoted to the utilization of remote sensing and a related 18-page section of color figures. 554 pp.

**The San Simeon, California, Earthquake of December 22, 2003.** This M 6.5 earthquake has relevance as a characteristic scenario anticipated for moderate-risk regions in other parts of the country that have a largely unretrofitted building stock. Numerous buildings throughout the area suffered significant damage and had to be demolished. In addition to structural and nonstructural performance, the report covers seismological, geological, and geotechnical effects; performance of lifelines; emergency response, recovery, and public policy implications. 84 pp.

**The 2002, Denali fault, Alaska, Earthquake** was the largest strike-slip event in North America in almost 150 years, rupturing a 340-km section along three faults in central Alaska.
